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IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING P2 WORK PERMITS FOR LANDED IMMIGRANTS TO CANADA

All landed immigrants to Canada must obtain an I-94 Departure Record from the U.S. CONSULATE located nearest to their city of residence, as opposed to a United States Port of Entry or Pre-Flight Inspection.

Landed Immigrants applying for Class P2 work permits must go through an additional screening process which is conducted by the U.S. Consulate in the city and province in which they reside. As a landed immigrant you are required to make an appointment at the appropriate U.S. Consulate to obtain your non-immigrant work status/permit. This appointment must be made minimum of (1) week and maximum of (10) days prior to the anticipated date of entry.

This process will involve completion of additional forms (DS156 and/or DS157) as well as an additional fee of \$100.00usd (approximately). An interview will be conducted by a Consulate Officer at the U.S. Consulate, and the musician/technician will be issued an I-94 Departure Record. The I-94 Departure Record, along with the original I-797B Approval Notice will be required of the landed immigrant musician/technician when entering the United States.
